



CITY OF WOONSOCKET, RHODE ISLAND INVITATION TO BID FOR:

“Proposal for Providing and Installing a Play Surface at WWII Park” **BID#5712**

Sealed proposals in duplicate, enclosed in an envelope labeled with the project name, and addressed to the Finance Director, City of Woonsocket, 169 Main Street, P. O. Box B, Woonsocket, RI 02895, will be received until **1:00 PM** on **Thursday February 25, 2016**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the second floor conference room.

The City of Woonsocket is soliciting proposals from vendors to provide and install a soft surface at the playground at WWII Park. The playground area is approximately 8,500 square feet and all play equipment has been recently installed. Currently, the grade of the sub base is approximately one foot below finished grade and the City’s Department of Public Works will prepare a gravel sub base to an elevation as identified by the selected vendor. The City will accept and consider proposals for various types of synthetic, turf or other rubberized surfaces designed and manufactured for playground use. The vendor is to include in their proposal, padding around the immediate area of the major pieces of apparatus with a fall height of seven feet, with the exception of the rope climbing structure which must have a fall height of 16 feet. The vendor must also submit evidence that the base they are providing meets manufacturers, ASTM and other national playground standards. All prospective bidders are encouraged to visit the site prior to the preparation and submission of their bid. Attached is a layout of the playground area with an identification of the pieces of play apparatus that have been installed.

In accordance with Rhode Island General Law 37-13-7, contracts in excess of \$1,000 shall require compensation based on *prevailing wages* for construction, alteration and/or repair, painting & decorating. Also, in accordance with Rhode Island General Law 44-1-6, nonresident contractors are subject to a 3% withholding of the contract price to secure payment of any sales tax, use tax, and/or income tax withheld that may be due the State of Rhode Island. The rates are available from the Rhode Island Department of Labor at (401) 462-8580, or access on the web: www.access.gpo.gov/davisbacon/allstates.html for the State forms. Proof of insurance, performance and payment bonds must also be submitted. In the event the City elects to fund this project with federal CDBG grants, a packet of contract requirements will be included in this invitation to bid.
