SNOW BAN PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM

The City of Woonsocket is pleased to announce a Snow Ban Parking Permit Program. This program will assist residents during snow emergencies find places to park their vehicles during declared parking bans.

Starting immediately, designated City parks, fields and other open areas will be open 24 hours a day during official snow bans ONLY as declared by the City.

Those parks and areas are as follows:

1. River Island Park (located across from 100 Bernon Street)
2. Dunn Park (located at 79 Asylum Street)
3. Bouley Field (located behind 450 Social Street)
4. Area outside soccer fields at Davison Street
5. Bernon Park (located at 145 Kermit Street)
6. Dionne Track (located at 366 Cumberland Hill Road)
7. Menard Field (located at 228 Privilege Street)
8. Old Middle School (located at 357 Park Place)

Permits may be purchased for twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars. Only persons who have obtained a Snow Ban Parking Permit shall be authorized to park in one of the above-designated areas during a snow ban. Any person wishing to purchase a Snow Ban Parking Permit must sign an agreement acknowledging the list of conditions associated with a Snow Ban Parking Permit issued by the Director of Public Works.

Parking spots are limited, and will be given on a first come first served basis.

Any vehicle parked in one of the above-designated areas without a Snow Ban Parking Permit shall be towed at the registered owner's expense.
