RECYCLE YOUR USED MOTOR OIL

HOW CAN YOU RECYCLE USED OIL?

Recycling used oil is easy.

1. Drain used oil into a suitable container with a tight-fitting cap, such as a thoroughly rinsed, heavy, plastic jug, which can be used over and over.

Note: Never mix used motor oil with any other liquids, such as: antifreeze, gasoline, paint thinner, solvents, cooking oil, or water!

2. Take the used oil to an Oil Recycling Facility.
