What is the Citizens Police Academy?

The Citizen's Police Academy provides an opportunity for citizens to interact with police officers to gain a better understanding of police work and the operations of their local police department. When & Where?

How do I become a member of the Citizens Police Academy?

Applicants must live or work in Woonsocket, be at least 18 yrs old, and be of good character.

Interested persons must apply by Aug 27, 2023.

There is no cost to attend the Academy.

Graduation from the program requires a minimum of 80% attendance. Please do not apply if you cannot meet this minimum requirement.
