Question 1: What is/are the appropriate Labor category/categories for which to request a prevailing wage determination from the Rhode Island Department of Labor?

We cannot find a category that this bid would require prevailing wages.

Question 2: What are the specified sizes for the plant materials? **See attached Distribution of Quantities.**

Question 3: What are the specified sizes for the plant materials?

Plant substitutions would need the approval of RIDEM

Question 4: Is there a watering/maintenance and warranty expectation for the installed plant materials? If so, what is the warranted period?

Plants should be guaranteed for one growing season, city to assume responsibility for watering.

Question 5: What standards will need to be followed in the plant material selection and installation?

RIDEM will be overseeing the planting and layout of the plants.

Question 6: The site plan in the document is difficult to read. The size of the restoration area is undefined. Please provide the square footage (acreage) of the area.

The restoration area is about 4,800 SF.

Question 7: Google Earth Pro shows historic area use for possibly construction staging or excavation/grading. Will there be any site preparation done before planting?

The area has already been cleared.

Question 8: The contract specifications note a work completion date of May 1, 2023 that may conflict with award notification/contracting. Please clarify.

We are still hoping to achieve this completion date.
