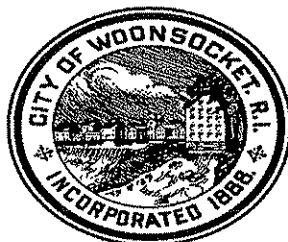

## Resolution

### **AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITY PROPERTY (THE EXTERIOR & INTERIOR SPACE OF THE MUSEUM OF WORK & CULTURE & THE APPLICATION OF TAPE ART BY RIVERZEDGE ARTS & TAPE ART TO CREATE AND PROVIDE A PUBLIC ART EXHIBIT)**

**WHEREAS,** RiverzEdge Arts and TAPE ART wish to utilize certain property of the City, the Museum of Work & Culture, from Monday, August 7<sup>th</sup> to Monday, August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017, from 9:00 A.M. to closing time for the purpose of holding a public arts exhibit, the "TAPE ART" Public Art Project.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOONSOCKET, RHODE ISLAND, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** RiverzEdge Arts and TAPE ART is hereby permitted to utilize the Museum of Work & Culture on Monday, August 7<sup>th</sup> to Monday, August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017, from 9:00 A.M. to closing time for the purpose of holding a public art exhibit, the "TAPE ART" Public Art Project, provided that any outdoor exhibits / exhibits on the exterior of the subject building shall last for a period of no more than four days during the period of August 7<sup>th</sup> through August 28<sup>th</sup>.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Council and is subject to any conditions that the Public Safety Department may impose.
