**Woonsocket Property Tax Bills to be Mailed Tuesday, August 17,  
Payment Grace Period Extended to September 3**

**Woonsocket, R.I.:** Mayor Lisa Baldelli-Hunt announced today that the City of Woonsocket will mail FY 2022 tax bills for real estate and tangible personal property on Tuesday, August 17, 2021. The first quarter payment due date has been extended until September 3, 2021. Motor Vehicle tax bills for the current fiscal year were previously mailed on July 8, 2021.

Mayor Baldelli-Hunt stated, "Our property tax bills are going out on Tuesday and the majority of our real estate taxpayers will be seeing a smaller bill because our real estate tax rates are lower than last year." The Mayor added, "Many of our Woonsocket residents are still recovering from the economic and social fallout from COVID-19, and our reduced real estate tax bills in combination with this year's lower motor vehicle tax bills resulting from the State phaseout will give most of our Woonsocket taxpayers meaningful tax relief during these difficult times."

The City is making tax payments as convenient as possible and is offering the following ways to pay your taxes:

- Tax payments can be brought in-person directly to the Treasury Department at Woonsocket City Hall.
- You can mail your tax payment to: City of Woonsocket, Treasury Division, PO Box B, 169 Main Street, Woonsocket, RI 02895.
