- -Americans use 2.5 million plastic bottles every hour.
- -The average American uses 650 pounds of paper each year - 100 million tons of wood could be saved each year if all that paper was recycled.

- -Vehicle Batteries
- Books (CDs. VHS tapes)
- Propane tanks
- Vegetable oil
- Automotive antifreeze
- Clothes/Shoes
- Rigid plastic (plastic toys, plastic outdoor furniture, old trash cans, kiddie pools, etc.)
- All Electronics (TV's, microwaves, air conditioners, computers, monitors, cell phones, items with power cords, etc.)



THINGS TO KEEP OUT OF YOUR RECYCLE CART

Liquids

Bottles and jugs should be emptied of liquids before placing in your green recycle cart. Also place the cap in the recycle cart.

Needles

Needles should be placed in a hard container like a bleach bottle or coffee can, capped and taped shut, labeled 'SHARPS' and placed trash cart. They get wrapped around in your regular trash cart.

Items in Plastic Trash Bags

When haulers see anything in plastic bags, they have been trained to treat them as trash. We need loose recyclables at our Material Recycling Facility.

Window Blinds

Window blinds are to be placed in the the machinery.

Hazardous Waste Containers that held hazardous

waste such as automotive fluid or pesticides must be specially treated. Call 942-1430 ext. 241 for more information.

Plastic Grocery Bags

Plastic Grocery Bags can only be recycled through our ReSTORE program. You can find collection boxes for your bags at most grocery/retail stores and at the City material recycle facility.

Propane Tanks
