

Items accepted for **FREE**:

- ♦ Paper, cardboard (newspapers, catalogs)
- ♦ Commingle (1-7 plastics, bottles, cans)
- ♦ ALL Metal items (steel, aluminum, cast iron, copper)
- ♦ Books (CDs, VHS tapes)
- ♦ Propane tanks
- ♦ Clothes/Shoes
- ♦ Vegetable oil
- ♦ Antifreeze
- ♦ Appliances (refrigerators, stoves, etc.)
- ♦ Rigid plastic:
 - Crates, buckets, totes
 - Plastic outdoor furniture
 - Old trash cans
 - Kiddie pools
- ♦ Mattresses/Box springs (Woonsocket residents only, identification is checked) must bring materials to bag or wrap and seal in plastic after inspection by City personnel
- ♦ All Electronics (Woonsocket residents):
 - TV's
 - Microwaves
 - Air conditioners
 - Computers
 - Monitors
 - Cell phones
