WHITE GOODS and BULK ITEMS PROGRAM

'White Goods' are large metal items that are recyclable that won't fit into the carts such as: refrigerators, dryers, dishwashers (see complete list posted on the City's Solid Waste web site). These items require an ORANGE sticker. Each unit in the program is allowed one (1) 'White Good' item per week. After obtaining an ORANGE sticker, the resident/property owner must contact Waste Management (telephone number 1-800-972-4545) to schedule an appointment for the pick up of the item. 'White Goods' are picked up on a weekly basis.

'Bulk Items' are non-recyclable items that won't fit into the burgundy carts such as: mattresses/box springs, couches, chairs, tables, rugs, etc. These items require a GREEN sticker. Each unit in the program is allowed one (1) 'Bulk Item' per month. After obtaining a GREEN sticker, the resident/property owner must contact Waste Management (telephone number 1-800-972-4545) to schedule an appointment for the pick up of the item. For mattresses and box springs see the [Mattress Program](#). All other 'Bulk Items' are picked up on a weekly schedule.

Stickers can be obtained at City Hall in the Public Works Department, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:00 pm. Proper identification and proof of residency/ownership is required.

'White Goods' and 'Bulk Items' can only be placed curbside for pickup after 7 p.m. the evening before the scheduled appointment.

Individuals not receiving City curbside rubbish/recycling pick up are excluded from this program. However, any and all 'White Goods' can be brought to the City Recycle Facility at 943 River Street during hours of operation FREE of charge, no sticker is needed. This includes all properties in the City.
